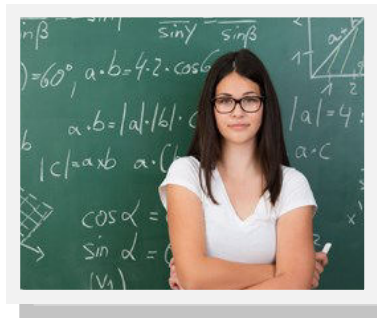
Developing Leadership Skills in Teachers
